**SCOTTISH INTERNATIONAL VETERANS
BADMINTON CHAMPIONSHIPS
CONDITIONS**

1. No player shall be eligible to compete unless he or she is a player in good standing with his or her national association.
2. The Championships will be conducted under the rules of the International Badminton Federation and the Scottish Badminton Union, including the prohibition of doping, for which tests may be carried out.
3. The Committee may restrict entries into all events.
4. YONEX shuttlecocks will be used.
5. Entries must be sent to **BADMINTONscotland**, Cockburn Centre, 40 Bogmoor Place, Glasgow G51 4TQ, accompanied by the appropriate remittance for entry fees, **NOT LATER THAN, FRIDAY 22nd DECEMBER 2006**
6. Late entries and entries sent without the appropriate entry fees will not be accepted.
7. No pair shall be accepted for a doubles event unless entry forms have been received from both players.
8. No entry will be accepted from any player who has taken part in any unauthorised Tournament, League or Match.
9. All players must be prepared to play at 9.00 am on Saturday 20 and at 9.00 am on Sunday 21 January. Men's singles ties are likely to be played on the evening of Friday 19th from 19.00hrs.
10. The period for knocking up before any match shall not exceed three minutes.
11. Clothing and advertising must conform to the International Badminton Federation Regulations which are effective from 1 August 1997.
12. All matches shall be the best of three games to 21. An interval not exceeding sixty seconds shall be permitted when a player/pair reaches eleven points in any game. An interval not exceeding two minutes shall be allowed between games.
13. Players must have reached the required age for the categories entered by 1st January 2007.
14. A player may enter a maximum of three events, which may be in different age groups, but a player may NOT enter the same event in more than one age group.
15. The Committee reserves the right to play any or all events in pool or round robin formats. A final will be held for every event for which two or more entries are received.
16. The Committee reserves the right to add to or alter these Conditions. Its decisions in all matters are final.
17. Late entries and entries sent without the appropriate entry fees are unlikely to be accepted. Late entries may only be accepted at the discretion of the tournament director. A financial penalty is imposed by **BADMINTONscotland** of £5 per event for late entries to these Championships.
18. Regarding unannounced withdrawals from tournaments, a warning letter will be sent on the first offence and on a subsequent offence the matter will be referred to the Disciplinary Committee.
19. The new scoring system, as adopted by the IBF in May 2006 will be used in all events.
