National Coach Doubles/Mixed (m/f/d)

starting on September 01, 2021.

The full-time position is initially limited to December 31, 2024. In case of continued employment the transfer to a permanent contract will take place. The salary will be agreed on the basis of the respective qualifications. Under certain circumstances, a later start date (January 01, 2022 at the latest) is possible.

Objectives

The main task for the coach is to plan and implement the training and support of the doubles and mixed players in coordination with the team of national coaches and to accompany them at tournaments in Europe and throughout the world with the aim of reaching "world class" level, i.e. success at the Olympic Games, World/European Championships and world ranking tournaments. In addition, the coach is to contribute to the further development of the DBV high performance sports program, especially in the areas of human resource development and coach education.

Main tasks and responsibilities

- Training and coaching of the national squad players several times a day at the national training center for doubles/mixed in Saarbrucken incl. preparation of training plans as part of the DBV training/playing philosophy
- Training and coaching of the national teams at central training measures and competitions
- Definition of individual programs with result and development targets that enable the national squad players to develop their potential in the best possible way
- Close cooperation with external experts for e.g. video, science, medicine, physiotherapy, psychology
- Active participation in the development of the coaching staff and coach education
- Contribution to the development of the German badminton junior players in doubles/mixed
- Cooperation in other areas of the high performance badminton sport in Germany on request

Qualifications/requirements

- BWF Level 3 or a comparable (foreign) coach education or German coach diploma or A-trainer for German applicants, a
 degree in sports science or comparable is desirable
- Several years of coaching experience at international top level
- Knowledge and experience in load management, training and coaching of top players
- Knowledge and experience in athletics and mental training
- Leadership skills not only in his/her area of expertise, but also in managing the group work environment with athletes and other coaches, administrators and supporting staff
- · He/she demands high and ambitious standards in terms of development and results
- He/she inspires and supports the team, creates a strong feeling of team identity
